The Guam Power Authority is seeking individual(s) interested in acquiring knowledge, and skills leading up to journeymen level positions in the field of transmission and distribution systems through completion of an Apprenticeship Training Program.

MINIMIUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- Shall be a high school graduate or possess a GED equivalency (High school diploma or GED certificate required)
- Shall be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Shall possess the basic aptitudes essential to acquiring the skills and proficiencies of the occupation.
- Shall be physically able to perform all the essential functions of the occupation without endangering the health and safety of themselves and/or fellow workers.

PLACEMENT EXAMINATION:

A written and an oral examination will be conducted for all applicants meeting the minimum qualifications.

DETERMINATION OF ELIGIBLITY:

Eligibility for the Apprenticeship Training Program can be determined by the following:

- 1. Management's review of all required documentation.
- Acceptable passing score in the written examination.
- 3. An oral interview with a panel as designated by the General Manager.
- 4. A complete physical examination upon Notice of Selection. Applicant must be physically capable of performing the essential functions of the occupation to be learned.

DRUG TESTING:

In accordance with GPA's Drug Free Workplace Policy, all applicants tentatively selected for this position will be required to submit to a urinalysis test to screen for illegal drug use prior to appointment.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Public Law 99-603 (8 USC Section 1324A) requires the Government of Guam to verify the identity and work eligibility to all newly hired employees. All new employees shall be required to provide proof of identity and work eligibility to work in the United States. The Government of Guam is required to comply with this law on a non-discriminatory basis. If you are hired to fill a position in the Government of Guam, you will be required to present valid documents that will establish your identity and work eligibility.

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to P.L. No. 28-98, "No person convicted of a sex offense under the provisions of Chapter 25 of Title 9 GCA, or an offense as defined in Article 2 of Chapter 28, Title 9 GCA in Guam, or an offense in any jurisdiction which includes, at a minimum, all of the elements of said offenses, or who is listed on the Sex Offender Registry shall work in any agency or instrumentality of the Government of Guam".
