RESOLUTION NO. 17-16

**RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO JOAQUIN “DANNY”
SANTOS FOR HIS SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS**

WHEREAS, upon the resignation of Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. as a member of the Board of Regents, the University of Guam community wishes to express its sincere gratitude for his dedication and service; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. attended George Washington High School, earned a bachelor’s degree from University of Dayton (Ohio), earned a master of arts degree from Pepperdine University, and is a graduate of the Joint Forces Staff College, Communication Officer School, and Electronic Warfare Analyst School; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. retired from the United States Marine Corps as Colonel after 26 years of command and staff assignments, after which he returned to Guam and was employed in communications industry management; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. is an active member of the Nino Perdido Parish (Asan) and has served as Parish Council President, Finance Council Member, lector, and extra-ordinary minister; and has also served as a member of the Municipal Planning Council for Asan and Maina; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. began his term as a member of the Board of Regents on May 1, 25, 2015, and served until his resignation effective February 10, 2017 due to medically related issues; ; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the Board of Regents, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. served on the Academic, Personnel and Tenure Committee and the Budget, Finance, Investments and Audit Committee; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr., also served as the first Chairperson for UOG’s Unfair Labor Practice Appeal Adjudication Committee and held the committee’s first case; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr., brought tremendous organization experience to the BOR and provided valuable positive influence in developing and shaping UOG policy; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr.’s commitment and leadership in support of UOG and higher education as a BOR member is recognized, commended and greatly appreciated; and

WHEREAS, Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. is highly regarded for his ethics, good judgement, and fairness in decision-making.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Regents of the University of Guam, the administration, faculty, staff and students, convey to Joaquin “Danny” Santos Jr. their sincerest gratitude for his dedication to UOG and the people of Guam, for his service as a member of the Board of Regents, and for his devotion to the growth and prosperity of our island; and
