





**1. Which type of degree did you earn from UOG? (check all that apply)**







**6. Are you employed or have you secured employment?**





**7. The next few questions pertain to your employment right after graduating from UOG. Were you working while you were attending UOG?**







**10. In what range is your current salary?**





**11. How well did your UOG education prepare you for your job?**









**15. Did this financial aid require you to work in Guam after you graduated?**





**16. Were you able to meet this obligation?**





**17. Are you currently in the military service, national guard, or reserves?**





**18. Are you a veteran?**




