## CALL FOR PROPOSALS

The committee of the University of Guam's 35th Annual Regional Language Arts Conference (LAC) invite educators, administrators, and the community to attend and present at the Language Arts Conference which will be held **in-person** on Friday, **November 18, 2022** and Saturday, **November 19, 2022**.

The 33rd & 34th LAC conferences, themes of "Navigating Waves of Literacy in the Pacific" and "Enhancing Our Classrooms to Navigate Beyond the Four Walls" has set us on a journey of looking at the ways that existing spaces of literacy have had to reinvent itself to accommodate emerging challenges. In these past two conferences, we were primarily focused on identifying these challenges and then identifying ways to overcome them. In the new leg of our journey, the 35th Annual Regional Language Arts Conference theme of "**Recharting Known Shores of Literacy**" not only invites a continued reflection of the ways that the COVID-19 pandemic has forced a reimagination of the things that were, but it also asks us, educators and learners, to revisit our visions of what literacy spaces should be and achieve.

In line with the University of Guam's Jubilee celebration, we are hoping that this theme of "**Recharting Known Shores of Literacy**" prompts conversations that invite us to look at how the things we know and the things we have done inform a need to reorient, remap, or reconfigure our ways and approaches. We hope that this conference blooms in reflection of the existing history of what was imagined, what has been achieved, and what can be further imagined.
