## Eligibility Criteria:

- ✓ U.S. Citizen or meets the residency requirements for Federal student financial aid.
- ✓ Enrolled or accepted to UOG.
- ✓ Demonstrate an Academic Need.

# And meet any of the following:

- ✓ First generation college student (neither parent nor legal guardian received a baccalaureate degree).
- ✓ Low-income based on federal guidelines.
- ✓ Student with disability (physical and/or learning.)
